## **bob** (Best of the Best) 2017 Forum Design Awards Competition Member Entry Form & Registration Fees

- Entry Form(s) and Registration Fee(s) must be received no later than 5PM Friday, December 2nd, 2016 and may be sent via e-mail (or by regular mail, if payment by check).
- Registration Number(s) and Project Submission Criteria will be sent via e-mail, upon receipt of both the Entry Form(s) and Registration Payment(s). The submission form will be emailed to you within 48 business hours upon receipt of the Entry Form(s).
- Project Submissions are due on Friday, December 29<sup>th</sup>, 2016 by 5PM.
- SPECIAL NOTE TO THE WINNERS – You will have the opportunity to speak at the event upon receiving the bob Award.
- The bob Forum Design Awards is the highest honor that IIDA Georgia can bestow upon a design team. The awards recognize design excellence and creativity that strives to continuously push boundaries and exceed expectations. The 2017 IIDA bob Forum Design Awards will be held on Thursday, February 23rd 2017.

### ELIGIBILITY

- All project entries must be executed by design firms and/or individuals located within the jurisdiction of the IIDA Georgia Chapter.
- Design Teams must include a minimum of one IIDA Professional or Affiliate Member (application for membership may be pending, but must be approved prior to January 1, 2017).
- Projects may have been executed anywhere in the United States or abroad and must have been completed no earlier than January 1, 2015.
- The number of projects submitted is not limited, however, a separate Entry Form must accompany each project submission.
- Prior publication or entry in other competitions does not affect eligibility. Projects that have previously won an IIDA bob (Best of the Best) Forum Design Award are not eligible.

### INSTRUCTION

- For each project entered into the bob Forum Design Award Competition, complete ALL information on the Entry Form, and send along with the associated Registration Fees.
- A single payment may be provided for all entries combine. Please complete all payment information on the last two pages. Entry Fees are not refundable.
- Registration Number(s) and Project Submission Instructions and Information will be provided via e-mail upon receipt of both the Entry Form(s) and Registration Payment(s).

## FORUM DESIGN AWARD CATEGORY DESCRIPTIONS

Forum Design Award Categories are described below, and are provided for your reference. Submitting Firms/Individuals must choose the Category which best describes their Project.

- Assembly** Specific to large-scale venues which handle high volumes of people for congregation, entertainment and/or transportation: Religious Institutions; Convention Centers; Civic Centers; Arenas; Stadiums; Transportation Terminals; etc.
- Corporate (Small)** Specific to the operation of public or private business: Financial Institutions; Professional Offices; Industrial Facilities Complexes; Corporate Offices/ Satellite Offices; Public Utilities; Call Centers; etc. **Less than or equal to 35,000 square feet.**
- Corporate (Large)** Specific to the operation of public or private business: Financial Institutions; Professional Offices; Industrial Facilities Complexes; Corporate Offices/ Satellite Offices; Public Utilities; Call Centers; etc. **Greater than 35,000 square feet.**
- Education & Research** Specific to study, learning and research: Research and Development Facilities; Day Care Centers; Educational Facilities; Colleges; Universities; Schools; Museums; Private Libraries; Aquariums; etc.
- Government** Specific to those funded and originated in idea by and for the Government: Government Agency Facilities; Public Libraries/ Museums; Correctional Facilities/ Judicial Facilities; Legislative Facilities; Military Base Lodging/ Officers Clubs; Fire/ Police/ Emergency Stations; Family Services Center; etc.



- Healthcare (Small)** Specific to the health & welfare of the general public: Senior Living Centers; Surgery Centers; Rehabilitation Centers; Cancer Centers; Children and Women's Centers; Retirement Communities; Clinics; Satellite Facilities/ Outpatient Treatment; Hospice; Medical/ Wellness Offices; Hospitals/ Additions and / or Renovations; Veterinary Facilities; etc. **Less than or equal to 35,000 square feet.**
- Healthcare (Large)** Specific to the health & welfare of the general public: Senior Living Centers; Surgery Centers; Rehabilitation Centers; Cancer Centers; Children and Women's Centers; Retirement Communities; Clinics; Satellite Facilities/ Outpatient Treatment; Hospice; Medical/ Wellness Offices; Hospitals/ Additions and / or Renovations; Veterinary Facilities; etc. **Greater than 35,000 square feet.**
- Historic Preservation** Specific to the preservation and restoration of historically significant venues.
- Hospitality (Small)** Specific to providing a service or entertainment venue for the purpose of (personal or business related) travel, rest and relaxation: Hotels; Resorts; Restaurants; Bars; Cruise Ships; Commercial Airlines; Theaters; Country Clubs; Athletic Clubs; Entertainment Clubs; Airline Clubs; Casinos; Theme Parks; Cineplex's; Spas; etc. **Less than or equal to 35,000 square feet.**
- Hospitality (Large)** Specific to providing a service or entertainment venue for the purpose of (personal or business related) travel, rest and relaxation: Hotels; Resorts; Restaurants; Bars; Cruise Ships; Commercial Airlines; Theaters; Country Clubs; Athletic Clubs; Entertainment Clubs; Airline Clubs; Casinos; Theme Parks; Cineplex's; Spas; etc. **Greater than 35,000 square feet.**
- Residential** Specific to personal living: Single Family Homes; Model Homes; New Construction; Restoration and Renovation; Mobile Homes; Public Housing; Multiple Units (Condo, Apartments, or Lofts); Community Projects/ Community Shelters; Yachts/ Planes/ Jets (Personal or Private); etc.
- Retail** Specific to selling products: Shopping Centers; Malls; Food Courts; Mass Merchandisers; Duty-Free Stores; Department Stores; Specialty Stores & Boutiques; Food Stores; Convenience Stores; Home Improvement Stores; Product Showrooms; Kiosks / Retail Outlets; Furniture Galleries; etc.
- Sustainability** Specific to environmental sustainability through Design: All entries may also submit their solution for innovative approaches to sustainable design. Submission criteria has been updated and tailored to this Category
- Multi-Family** Specific to a classification of housing where multiple separate housing units for residential inhabitants are contained within one building or several buildings within one complex. New construction or renovation of apartments, condos or dormitories.
